## A BUSY SUMMER AT NCS

It is no surprise that the wonderful people at Nicaragua Christian School have been busily serving the Lord. In April they hosted a ladies conference that was highly successful. Five hundred women attended. On June 24, 481 attended a conference for mothers with children at the school. On July 30, the school hosted leadership conference that had 112 in attendance.

For a number of years, the Salem Creek church of Christ in Murfreesboro, Tennessee has conducted a VBS at Nicaragua Christian School. Due to Covid 19, they have been unable to do this for the past three years. This year the school planned and conducted VBS. Attendance was very good with 200 on Sunday, 283 on Monday, and 254 on Tuesday.

We commend our brothers and sisters in Nicaragua for their dedication to the Lord. Their vision and determination are incredible.
