I learned to have tolerance love for myself and others. This is not just a school which simply teaches, it also distributes love to each of the children and each of the families. It is a school where you would like to stay all the time. This school gives you a clear example of how you should love your neighbor how you should help contribute even a small detail. Although we see it that way that little one, that little detail can change someone’s life just like it did with me. This school gave me a 360 degree turn, yes that way. It was great because it turned what I thought was going to be my life. When I entered this school I had no hope, I thought that my studies were not going to be done.
